Phil D'Amato started his thoroughbred racing career in Kentucky, and after several years, he moved home to Southern California under the tutelage of the late racing icon Mike Mitchell. After ten years with Mitchell, D'Amato took over the barn when Mitchell retired in 2014.

D'Amato hit the board right out of the gate winning more than 80 races, including Grade 1 winners **OBVIOUSLY** and **STREET FANCY**. D'Amato has also trained star thoroughbreds **GOLD PHOENIX (IRE)**, **MIDNIGHT STORM**, **BOWIES HERO**, **STRONGHOLD**, **GOING GLOBAL**, **DESERT DAWN**, **BALNIKHOV**, **COUNT AGAIN**, **COUNT AGAIN** and **MOTORIOUS**, among many others.
